

EVANGELLOS MYTILINEOS ON CNN

Mr. Evangelos Mytilineos, Chairman and CEO of MYTILINEOS Group, gave today a live interview on CNN. In "World Business Today", airing from London, Mr. Mytilineos answered the questions of the well-known emerging markets editor, John Defterios, on how the private sector sees the country's inefficiency to meet troikas' demands and the growing scenarios of bankruptcy.



Mr. Mytilineos highlighted the fact that up to now the private sector is the one paying the bill, with over 1 million people unemployed. He also noted that it is a matter of survival, for everyone, politicians and society, to do our best to stand up on the situation and marked that it is high time for the government to undertake all actions necessary for the materialization of the 21st of July agreement. He also noted that there is disappointment from the delays in the implementation of the privatization plan and that it is crucial to meet the time-limits set by troika.
